After completing this course, students take the second required writing ourse, WRIT 150 Reading, Writing & Research II.

Option 2 - WRIT1200Reading, Writing & Research PLUS

In the Writir gudio, students work with their professoron writing projects and otherwork from the course. Students who complete this course successfully moven to WRIT1500Reading, Writing Research II.

Option 3 - WRIT1060AcademicWriting Process
